The Greene County Tech Educational Foundation is extending the opportunity to certified staff (teachers, counselors, media specialists, etc.) to secure additional funding to improve student achievement.

The grants are to be used to initiate projects that will provide educational materials to enrich and enhance the school curriculum and to improve student achievement.

- Eligibility: All PK-12 GCT Certified staff
- Amount: Maximum amount of request is \$500.00
- Deadline: All applications must be received in the GCT Administration Office by 3:30pm on **Friday, May 20, 2022.** Late applications will not be accepted.
- Proposals: Each individual teacher may submit only one proposal. Proposals from groups of teachers will not be considered. Proposals can not be the exact same as another applicant's project.
- Number of Grants: The Educational Foundation Board of Directors will award six (6) \$500.00 instructional grants that meet the application requirements in August, 2022.

Application:

- ⇒ Complete and send five (5) copies of the Instructional Grant application. Be sure the name of the teacher completing the grant is only on the first page of the grant application.
- ⇒ Grants that meet the application requirements will be awarded in August, 2022 hopefully at the beginning of school celebration if the district gets to host one.
- ⇒ The grant application must be typed.
- ⇒ Fax copies will not be accepted.

Application Checklist:

- ✓ School/Teacher name is listed on the top of the grant request.
- ✓ Directions have been followed.
- ✓ Application is signed by the principal.
- ✓ Five (5) copies of the application are submitted with one copy of the application cover sheet.
- ✓ Expenditures are listed in detail and include tax, shipping, and handling. Make a best estimate.
- ✓ Application is returned by 12:00pm on **Friday, May 20th, 2022.**

6. Evaluation – How will you evaluate or measure the effectiveness of this grant project?

Note on Presentation of your Proposal – In evaluating each grant application, the committee will review each grant based upon its clarity, completeness, grammar, spelling, punctuation, and form.
